### **About our guest – Fr Austin McGirr**

Fr Austin McGirr was appointed to Portstewart as Parish Priest in April 2006. He was “surprised and delighted – like a lottery winner” and has quickly settled into the community. Fr Austin was ordained for Down & Connor in 1971 and Portstewart is the eighth parish in which he has been asked to serve.
